Wisconsin Association of FFA February Board of Directors Meeting Recap February 14, 2024 - Rothschild, Wisconsin

- 1. Recap of 2024 District Leadership Development Events
 - a. District LDE results were presented to the Board in preparation for the Sectional LDEs.
 - b. Discussion occurred around various experiences at District Contests to note for future competitions
 - c. Mrs. Crook reviewed procedures for hosting the Sectional LDEs and provided materials to the state officers and their advisors.
 - d. The Board voted to not allow any member to compete in the Sectional LDE Competitions virtually. Motion passed.
- 2. Updates were provided on applications, career development events, upcoming conferences, FFA Foundation and proficiency judging.
- 3. An FFA membership update was provided. A discussion was conducted over the concern of several chapters with outstanding invoices. Mrs. Ladsten provided a brief overview of the Association budget which will be further discussed through the finance committee meeting and at the March Board meeting.
- 4. State FFA Officer Task Force The Board approved the outline of rounds of interviews for the 2024 State FFA Election Process provided by the Task Force. Information will be created soon to put on the website. Additional support materials were suggested to be added to the website to help state officer candidates as well as resources for parents. There will be State FFA Officer Academies held for candidates. More planning and details will need to be provided.
- Realignment of FFA Districts and Sections The Board reviewed a model of readjustment of Districts and Sections. Suggestions were provided by the Board and additional models will be presented at the March Board Meeting for possible consideration at the business session of the State FFA Convention.
- 6. The Organic Proficiency Award updated description from the SAE Committee to align more with the SAE grant focusing more on sustainability was reviewed and ratified by the Board.
- 7. State Officers gave an update on the Blue Legacy program to provide FFA jackets to FFA members. Applications are coming in and will be reviewed.
- 8. Mrs. Ladsten provided an update on the State FFA Honors Band and Chorus assistant contracts.
- 9. Nominations for Honored Adult recognition was discussed.
- 10. The Board reviewed the tentative State Convention schedule provided by Mrs. Zimmerman
- 11. The Board voted to invite Nick Tokman as the State FFA Convention keynote speaker for Wednesday afternoon following the State FFA Degree Ceremony. It was also decided that the keynote speaker will be following the State FFA Degree ceremony during the Fourth Session on Wednesday afternoon.
- 12. Information about the procedure for electing the State FFA President was provided to the advisors and state officers by Mrs. Zimmerman
- 13. State FFA Convention housing for Board members and state officer parents was discussed.
- 14. The next FFA Board of Directors meeting will be March 14 at the Clarion Suites hotel in Marshfield. The evening of March 14 and Friday March 15, the FFA state officer advisors will be reviewing State FFA Degree applications.

The 2024 American Degree Review occurred on Thursday February 15 in conjunction with Farm Forum. We thank the state officer advisors as well as many other advisors that joined us during the day to conduct this review process.
