

Duties of the State FFA Officer's School

What are my duties and responsibilities as the State Officer's school?

- 1) To host the Sectional Leadership Workshops.
 - a) About 200+ students from 22-29 schools will be attending (at max and depending on section)
 - **b)** Need is about 10-15 classrooms
 - c) A main area for skit, opening and closing session (auditorium, cafeteria, some are with a stage)
 - d) One of the school administrators will also give a welcome speech
- 2) To host the Leadership Development Events
 - a) Your school could be blessed with both Districts and Sectional contests, but with a State Officer you will be hosting Sectionals
 - **b)** Expect about 100 members from 22-29 schools
 - c) This is a speaking competition, with 7 events hosted by the school
 - **d)** Need 10 classrooms
 - e) A school administrator will give a welcome to the students competing
- 3) Provide aid to State Officer
 - a) Four Newsletters (providing printing and mailing)
 - **b)** Access into the school
 - c) Having the ability to come to the school to work on items, or to be able to chat with their advisor.
 - d) They are basically a student at your high school, and are still a member of your high schools FFA chapter
- 4) State Convention
 - a) A school administrator to be recognized on stage at the Wisconsin State FFA Convention for their help in supporting the state officer
