

Wisconsin FFA Convention Restored Tractor/Equipment Display

This is not a contest but an opportunity for FFA members to highlight their hard work and talents in restoring farm equipment and tractors.

The program is pretty simple....

- 1) Let Matt Reinders, Display Manager, know if you are bringing a tractor or other piece of equipment that has been restored by a student or group of students as part of the agricultural education department.
- 2) Put together a few details on who owns the tractor, who helped restore the tractor and share the story of how the piece of equipment was restored.
- 3) Bring your piece of equipment on Monday of State Convention and take it home on Thursday after the last session.

Remember to bring pans/rags to put under the tractors....to catch any fluids or oil.

Note for Tractors:

1. Students do not need to be present next to tractors, but they are welcome to especially before and after sessions.
2. Tractors should arrive on Monday by early afternoon as they will need to be in place at 6:00 p.m.
3. Trucks and trailers can be parked in the front of the parking lot near the entrance to the Alliant Energy Center.
4. Tractors can be picked up after the last session is finished on Thursday anytime after 1:00 p.m.
5. Each tractor should have a sign stating the FFA Chapter name and member(s) who worked on the tractor. Also include the make/model, year and optional-story behind the tractor.
6. If you prefer, please post a sign stating: "Please be gentle with me" or "Not Touching or Sitting".
7. Tractors must have less than 1/4 tank of fuel. This is a requirement of the Alliant Energy Facility.
