



## 2023 Available Scholarships

### General criteria for all scholarships

1. The applicant must be a member in good standing of the Wisconsin Association of FFA through membership in a recognized FFA chapter.
2. The applicant must be at least a senior in high school or already enrolled in college and have maintained a satisfactory scholastic record in school.
3. The applicant must major in a program offered through an accredited university or technical college with special consideration given to students with interests in agriculture, unless specified by the sponsor.

Kenneth K. Heideman Endowment	\$1,000	1	Recipients must be from the Clintonville, Marshfield, or New Holstein FFA Chapters and pursuing an agricultural career major at a school in the University of Wisconsin System.

Farmer Community Giving, Organic Valley	\$800	1	The recipient must be high school senior from Viroqua, LaFarge, Westby, Kickapoo or Cashton FFA Chapter and pursuing a career in organic agriculture and/or agriculture.
Star Blends	\$400	1	Recipient must be majoring in animal science, dairy science, agricultural business, or agricultural economics with a focus on a career in sales, livestock, or animal nutrition.
Wisconsin Agri-Business Association	\$1,000	4	General criteria.

Wisconsin Rural Opportunities Foundation	\$1,000	2	Preference given to candidate with rural residence.
