Saving Emails

On the first page of the [application](#), enter your school email address (or your preferred email address). This email address is how you'll edit your responses, how we will communicate with you regarding your application, and how we will contact and announce the winners.

Saved vs Submitted Responses

The google form will save your *unsubmitted* responses for 30 days from last access. That means if you start your application (but don't submit) on 9/20, your responses will be available until 10/19; if you start your application on 9/20 and do not access it again until 11/1, those responses will be lost, and you will have to start your application again.

Your *submitted* application will be editable through 11/15; this means that starting and submitting your application will permit you to edit your application for the entire application period.

We highly recommend starting and submitting your application, then saving the "edit your responses" link available on both the confirmation page and in your confirmation email to continue working on your application.

We cannot see draft applications *and we cannot resend confirmation emails*, so submit early and [save the confirmation email!](#)

[ADVISOR APPROVAL](#)

Applications submitted online will require the applicant's advisor to complete an Advisor Approval Form ([.xlsx](#) & [.pdf](#)). Advisors must submit a separate form with an advisor's statement and their signature, confirming approval of the application. Forms are due no later than Tuesday, November 15, 2022 via email to awards@wisconsinffaoundation.org.



GENERAL SAE GRANT INFORMATION

- Grants will be awarded for initiating or improving an SAE program.
- Recipients will be determined by the grants award committee based on this application information. All grants are in the form of cash awards (checks) issued to recipients. All grants are paid to the recipient with the understanding that the award funds will be used to meet expenses of improving or starting their SAE. Checks are issued to the award winner upon receipt of the scanned copy of the thank you note to program sponsor.
- It is understood that anyone awarded an SAE Grant will complete a Final Report in order to be eligible for any future funding from the Wisconsin FFA Foundation. The Final Report will be due to the Foundation no later than May 15, 2023.
- A major part of the judging is based upon Advisor's statement addressing eligibility, participation, and financial need. *If you are not comfortable addressing any financial concerns with your advisor*, please be sure to select the appropriate box at the bottom of Section 1, so that the review committee can take your situation into consideration.

SAE GRANT REQUIREMENTS

- Applications must be submitted via the online registration system.
- Must be in grades 7-11 during the 2022-23 school year.
- Must presently be a member of the FFA. Members may apply for ALL grant areas for which they are eligible.
- Must be approved by the advisor.

- Include only requested application materials. No other materials should be uploaded.
- Limit one grant per student per year.
